#### B. INSTRUCTION FOR THE CANDIDATES

1. Application form is to be downloaded from university website, i.e., [www.awu.ac.in](http://www.awu.ac.in) which is required to be filled in and submitted within the last date of submission.
2. For programmes where entrance test is not conducted, filled in application form has to be submitted only after declaration of the final semester result of the qualifying examination. However, for under graduate and post graduate programmes for which entrance test is conducted, applicants awaiting their final results can apply.
3. Candidates shall have to appear before the Selection Committee as per date, time and venue with all original certificates, mark sheets, PRC and other documents at their own cost.
4. Candidates, if selected, shall have to take admission immediately after counselling on payment of necessary fees as given in Section 12 of this Information Bulletin. A candidate failing to take admission on the day shall forfeit the seat.

**5. No separate call letters will be issued to the applicants.**

## 1. THE UNIVERSITY

The Assam Women's University is the first state women University in the entire North Eastern Region of India which started functioning from the month of September, 2014. The University has been established by an Act (XXII) of 2013 of State Legislature of Assam as a State University vide Notification LGL.149/2011/92 dated 21.08.2013 and is empowered to award degrees as specified by the UGC under Section 22 of the UGC Act 1956 through its own departments. The main objectives of the University are as follows.

- a) To provide for facilities and offer opportunities to women for education in applied arts, technology, industry, commerce, management, applied sciences and social science by instruction, training, research, development and by such other means as the University may deem fit;
- b) To promote research in applied science and arts, technology, industry, commerce, management and social science for the advancement of knowledge and for the betterment of the society particularly with focus on women's perspective;
- c) To devise and implement programmes of education for women in applied science, arts, technology, industry, commerce, management and social science that are relevant to the changing socio-economic needs of the society, in terms of breadth of diversity and depth of specialisation;
- d) To serve as a center for fostering co-operation and exchange of ideas between the academic and research community on the one hand and industry on the other;
- e) Organize exchange programme with other institution of repute into India and abroad with a view to keeping abreast of the latest development areas of teaching and research.



## Mission

The mission of the University is to provide a level playing ground for the women of Assam with respect to accessing higher education for promoting their knowledge, competitiveness and skills so as to make them capable citizens to fill up the women talent gap in different spheres of societal, scientific, technological and other areas.

The ultimate goal of the University is to produce 21<sup>st</sup> century women knowledge and think-tanks to effectively carry forward the women centric opportunities in the state of Assam and to become a matching partner in national and global development.

### **8. ELIGIBILITY**

1. Only female candidates are eligible for admission.
2. A candidate for undergraduate degree programme shall be at least 17 years of age as on August 1, 2017 (i.e. must have been born before 01-08-2000).
3. Selection of eligible candidates for admission to BA in Psychology, Bachelor of Physiotherapy, MBA, MCA, MTTM, MLIS and MA in Mass Communication will be based on their performance in the entrance test. For other programmes, selection will be on the basis of merit in the qualifying examination.

#### **8.1 Eligibility Criteria for Under Graduate and Post Graduate Programmes**

During the session 2017-18, Assam Women's University offers two under graduate and thirteen post graduate programmes. Admission will be purely on merit basis keeping in view the reservation system of the Government of Assam. Following are the eligibility criteria of the offered programmes.

### **8.2 Procedure of holding the Entrance Examination**

- For Bachelor of Physiotherapy, questions will be on Physics, Chemistry, Biology and English from 10+2 level syllabus.
- For BA in Psychology, the test will assess candidate's English Proficiency, Reasoning and Basic Arithmetic skills.
- For MBA and MTTM written test, questions will be on Current Affairs, Quantitative Aptitude, Reasoning and English.
- For MCA and MLIS written test, questions will be on Reasoning, English and Computer Basics.
- For MA in Mass Communication, questions of the written test will be on Current Affairs, North-East Culture, Media, Language Skill, Comprehension /Grammar.
- For MBA and MA in Mass Communication programmes, written test will be followed by group discussion and/or personal interview.

### 9.1. How to apply

## 10. SELECTION AND ADMISSION PROCEDURE

Candidates will have to appear personally before the Selection Committee at their own expense, on scheduled date of admission.

### 10.1 RESERVATION OF SEATS

The University makes provisions for reservation of seats as per Government of Assam norms for eligible candidates belonging to the following categories. Certificates from the competent authorities against each of the reserved categories must be enclosed along with the filled-in application form. Self-certified copies of certificate mentioned against each of the categories must be submitted along with the application form, the original of which has to be produced at the time of admission.

- Scheduled Caste specified in relation to the state of Assam under Article 341 of the Constitution of India. **(Certificate from the competent authority countersigned by the Deputy Commissioner /Additional Deputy Commissioner): 7%**
- Scheduled Tribes (Plains and Hills) specified in relation to the state of Assam under Article 342 of the Constitution of India. **(Certificate from competent authority countersigned by the Deputy Commissioner /Additional Deputy Commissioner): ST(P) -10%, ST (H) – 5%**
- Other Backward Classes (OBC)/More Other Backward Classes (OBC) specified in relation to the state of Assam. **(Certificate from competent authority countersigned by the Deputy Commissioner /Additional Deputy Commissioner): 15%**
- Persons with Disabilities as per provisions of Section 39 under The Persons with Disabilities (Equal Opportunities, Protection of Rights and Full Participation) Act 1995.: **3%**



## 11. Admission of Foreign/NRI Students:

Foreign candidate seeking admission shall forward their application through their respective Embassy/Mission at New Delhi or through the respective Indian Missions abroad to the Government of India /University Grants Commission (UGC) and their candidature shall be considered if they are sponsored/ cleared by the Government of India/UGC. Necessary fees shall be charged at the rates prescribed by the UGC for the foreign candidates. Eligibility for admission of foreign students is as per qualification prescribed by the University. A good knowledge of English is essential. A certificate of candidates' proficiency in English issued by the respective Indian Mission abroad and recognized agencies should accompany their application for admission.

### 11.1 Documents required for admission of Foreign Students:

- i. Visa: All the international students will require a student visa endorsed to this Institution for joining full time courses. No other endorsement is acceptable. The visa should be valid for the prescribed duration of the course. Visa is not required for NRI students.
- ii. All international students will have to obtain prior security clearance from the Ministry of Home Affairs and the approval of Department of Secondary & Higher Education, Ministry of Human Resource Development Government of India.

### 11.2 PERMANENT RESIDENCE CERTIFICATE

All candidates must submit the Permanent Residence Certificate issued by the competent authority (Deputy Commissioner/District Magistrate/SDO Civil) of the Government.

### 11.3 GAP PERIOD CERTIFICATE

If a candidate discontinued her studies after the qualifying examination, she shall have to furnish a gap period certificate only from institute last attended.

### 11.4 PHYSICAL FITNESS

The candidate shall have to submit a duly filled-in prescribed format (**Annexure I**) along with the application form.

### 11.5 PAYMENT OF FEES

Subject to physical fitness of the candidates, being declared as such by the Medical Officer/ Medical Board, an eligible candidate has to take admission on payment of prescribed fees immediately after selection. **In case of failure to pay fees at the time of admission, the seat allotted to the candidate will stand forfeited and the seats(s) thus vacated will be allotted to the next candidates(s) in order of merit.**

### **13. LIBRARY**

Text and reference books for the various programmes shall be made available in the library.

### **14. RESIDENCE**

Limited hostel seats across all schools shall be allowed. Other students shall have to arrange their own accommodation till the facility comes up.

### **15. TEACHING**

#### **15.1 Choice -Based Credit System and Continuous Assessment:**

The AWU has followed the Choice-Based Credit System (CBCS) and Continuous Assessment in a semester. These are the important components of reform in higher education in India. In this Choice based credit system students are given opportunities to pursue courses of interest across discipline and schools in addition to their major course of interest. The number of credits in a course is closely related to the number of teaching-learning hours and the flexible curriculum enables students to pursue courses of their interest and obtain inter-disciplinary expertise.

AWU has also adopted the Lecture-Tutorial-Practical (L-T-P) structure which encourages students towards self-learning or learner centric approaches. The students have more opportunities to develop and nurture their creative abilities and exposed to the methodologies of academic work.

**Medium of instruction: English.**

#### **15.2 Academic Year**

The academic year of the University is from August to July. The academic year consists of two semesters.

#### **15.3 Courses**

During a semester, the students register themselves for a number of courses. A “Course” is a unit of instruction of a subject matter under any discipline carrying a specific number of “Credit Hours”

#### **15.4. Credit Hours**

“Credit Hours” Signify the quantum of work done corresponding to 1 hour of theory class or 2-3 hours of laboratory /field practical every week during a semester in respect of a particular course.

#### **15.5. Attendance**

A student is to maintain a minimum of 75 % attendance separately for theory and practical in each course failing which she shall be debarred from appearing in the End Term examination.

### **16. EXAMINATION**

Student performance for both Under Graduate (UG) and Post Graduate (PG) degree program shall be monitored throughout the semester by continuous assessment. There shall be university examinations (both theory and practical) at the end of each semester. But a continuous evaluation of students will be carried out by the course teachers during the progress of semester.

The evaluation scheme for each course shall contain two parts:

- a. Internal evaluation carried out during the period of continuation of semester.
- b. External evaluation at the end of the semester.

Internal evaluation shall involve two written tests as notified in the academic calendar.

The External evaluation during End Semester Examination (ESE) in theory courses shall be conducted by the University.

### **17. CLIMATE**

The climate of the state is pleasant for most part of the year. The winter lasts for about five months viz., from October to February. Though summer starts from March-April, the weather is quite pleasant. There is heavy rainfall during the months of July and August.

## 18. DRESS CODE

Students of MBA are to dress in navy blue trouser, blazer and sky blue shirt. The students should dress in college blazer during games, sports and other special occasions. Students of Physiotherapy are to dress in azure blue kurta, white salwar and dupatta with black winter wears. Students are to use white aprons during laboratory practical and clinical postings. For attending University functions and within the campus, every student is expected to be modestly dressed.

## 19. DISCIPLINE

All students are to maintain discipline and proper scholastic atmosphere during their stay at the University. On admission, students must acquaint themselves with the University and hostel rules and regulations. Ragging is completely banned in Assam Women's University. Any student found involved in ragging shall to stern disciplinary action as per the UGC Regulation on **“Curbing the menace of ragging in higher educational institution, 2009”**.



## 20. STUDENTS' WELFARE

### 20.1 Sports, Recreation, Social Service

The University shall gradually provide facilities for games and sports, music, study circle, drama and other co-curricular activities for overall personality development of the students admitted.

### 20.2. Medical facilities

The available facilities at the Assam Agriculture University, Jorhat shall be shared.

### 20.3. Students Magazine

There is provision for publishing a magazine to encourage creativity of the students. The students are to pay the magazine fee at the beginning of each academic year. The first issue of the University wall magazine '*Surujmukhi*' came out in September, 2014.

## **21. REFUND OF CAUTION MONEY**

Refund of caution money shall be made to a student after her release from the University. The claim of caution money shall not be entertained beyond a period of one year from the date of release. Release of caution money shall be made against application in prescribed form and production of release order. The caution money shall not be refunded if a student leaves the college without prior permission and/or does not join and attend any class after admission.
